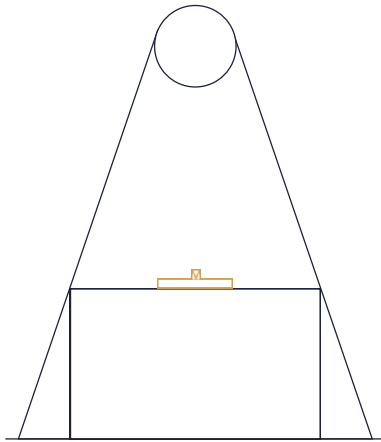

HOW TO USE YOUR SUNDIAL

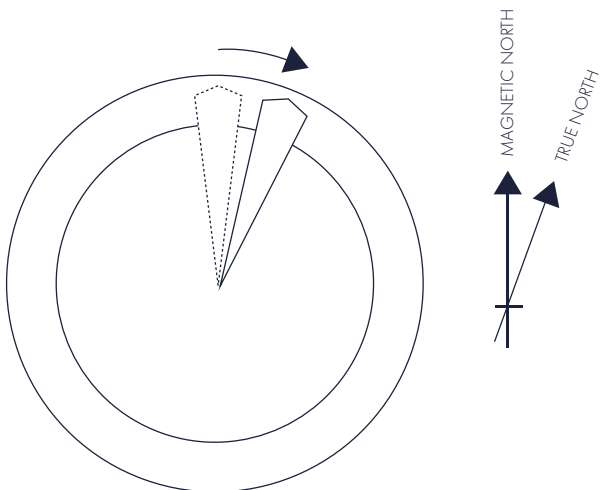
I

Place sundial on a flat surface in full, direct sunlight.



II

Point the gnomon towards true north.



Use the sun. At noon, the sun shines in the middle of the horizon and directly south. With your back directly to the sun, you are now facing true north.

Use GPS. Your GPS unit can provide you with true north. Your smartphone may also have an app to provide true north as well.

Use a compass. To find true north using an adjustable compass, find your local declination value (the angle difference between true north, magnetic north, and north on your compass).

III

The outer edge of the gnomon's shadow marks the current time.
